

Uncovering KOLs and Physicians in their Following



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Why should we care about key opinion leaders? It's because if they endorse your drug, then in one fell swoop, it's an army of physicians that may be prescribing your drug. Of course, they may not. The point? Knowing the KOL is not enough. You also need to know who lie in the catchment of the KOL. This opens up some sophisticated targeting strategies whereby a physician can be targeted from multiple directions: directly by the rep or indirectly through one or more KOL's.

<u>Practical question:</u> How to establish which physicians "follow" which physicians to use a term popularized by Twitter? It's through patient claims data. Indeed, since each patient is uniquely encrypted (by contrast, the physician is completely identified), following the trajectory of each patient - and this repeated millions of times - allows us to reconstruct the web of connections that link KOLs to physicians.


